### **Door Prize Challenge**

This year the 2018 Conference Committee is issuing a ‘door prize’ challenge to all members of HWSDA. In previous years we have relied on the generosity of members, members guilds and vendors to donate door prizes. This year the Conference Committee would like to add a twist to this. This is a golden opportunity to share leftover yarns or cone ends that were used for a weaving project or workshop. Perhaps you have a selection of fleece or rovings, surplus to your needs, suitable for needle or wet felting. Did you take a dye workshop and want to share some dye, samples and/or instructions for a project? Maybe a hand held project to bead, braid or crochet. Do use the conference theme colours (as shown in the logo) as an inspiration.

Think outside the box for ideas but within the box for giving.

To make it a further challenge, find another HWSDA member from another guild, or like-named individuals for example:

*We the Valeries of the South (Valerie Forcese & Valerie Schmaltz) challenge Valerie of the North (Valerie Phaneuf) to the 2018 HWSDA Conference Door Prize Challenge.*

Paying it forward, Valerie Phaneuf will in turn challenge another member and so on.

You can take this idea a step further by presenting your door prize in a *‘takeaway’* container. This could be as simple as brown paper lunch, shopping, cloth, cellophane or plastic bag, etc. Re-cycle what you have in your stash. Have fun with the *‘takeaway’* idea.
